Professor Obayan described the get-together as a kind of induction and opportunity for the international faculty to meet the management. She said most of them were interviewed on virtual space, but the meeting provides opportunity for physical contact to welcome them back home.



She stated that the Covenant University vision was a global one and as it is stated in the scripture in Isaiah 2: 2- 3:
