Covenant Author Tops Global Peers in the Field of Oil; Seeds; Fatty Acids

An author from Covenant University has emerged No. 1 in the top 5 list of the world's best authors by scholarly output, in the field of Oil; Seeds; Fatty Acids.

According to the latest computations made by Elsevier SciVal, the quick and easy access to the research performance of 8500 research institutions and 220 countries worldwide, the No. 1 author in the field Oil; Seeds; Fatty Acids, Professor Abiodun Adebayo of the Department of Biological Sciences, Covenant University, led with 3 scholarly outputs, 18 views count, and field-weighted citation impact of 0.18.

Professor Adebayo's research interests include Biochemical, Phytochemical, and Toxicity Studies of Some Medicinal Plants commonly found in our locality; and Clinical Biochemistry of Viral and Cancer-Related Diseases.
